## Sanction #:

UT-026

"In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that Utah Swimming and USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event."

Whether entries are submitted electronically or on paper, by the action of entering the swimmer in the meet the submitter whether the swimmer, coach, parent or team representative, certifies that the swimmer is a registered member of USA Swimming and that all times stated in/on the entry are true and correct. The submitter further assumes responsibility for any false or incorrect times, and understands that all listed entry times are subject to Utah Swimming Time Verification Procedures, and that a fine of \$20.00 shall be paid to Utah Swimming, Inc. for each incorrect time, unless corrected before the entry deadline. It is understood that an automatic call before the review section shall be the result for a third entry time that cannot be verified. The submitter further agrees that a penalty of \$100.00 shall be assessed to anyone entering a swimmer in a meet sanctioned by Utah Swimming, Inc. who is not registered with USA Swimming at the time of entry, upon it being proven that the swimmer was not so registered.

## Rules:

2009 USA Swimming Rules will apply.

## Coaches Check List:

There will be a coaches checklist at the Clerk of Course to verify coaches USA registration. All Coaches will need to check in.

## Eligibility:

This meet is open to all 2010 registered USA/Utah registered swimming athletes 14 & under who have achieved the qualifying times attached with this information. Only attached swimmers currently registered with Utah clubs will be eligible to score team/club points. The swimmers age as of Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010 shall determine the age for the entire meet. No deck registration will be accepted; swimmers must be registered at time of entry.

**Disabled USA/Utah registered swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per USI policy. For additional information see the section below on adaptive swimming.**

## Entries:

Individual swimmers may enter up to **EIGHT (8) individual events**, swimming no more than **THREE (3) individual events** and 1 relay per day. Teams must designate a Team Entry Representative on the Team Information Sheet. This person will be the only one to submit entries and/or make changes to the entries.

### **Relay Entries:**

Only USA Registered athletes and teams may compete in relay events. Relay entries are limited to no more than 2 entries per event per team. Teams wishing to enter the 2 relays per event must meet the relay qualifying time for both teams for that event. Qualifying times may be met by aggregate times or by an actual time swum. Teams wishing to enter only one relay per event must make sure that two swimmers on that relay are swimming individual events in this meet. Time verification will be enforced on all relays not meeting the qualifying times. Teams using the "2 swimmers in the meet" qualifying system will be allowed to enter the relay with a NT (No Time) entry time if they so choose; teams entering 2 relays per event must enter with achieved qualifying times (aggregate or actual). *Please note that there is not a 10 & Under 400 Free Relay.*

Each coach shall pick up relay entry forms from the Clerk of Course on which they shall list the competing relay swimmers, their first and last names, ages and order of swimming for each entered relay. **Initial relays declarations must be returned to the clerk of course by 11 AM on the day the event will be swum.** Upon reporting to the blocks, immediately prior to the start of the relay heat in which the team is entered, the FINAL relay entry form shall be handed to the head lane timer. No change will be permitted thereafter and failure to present the head lane timer with a written list of relay swimmers shall prevent such teams from competing. A runner shall be furnished to distribute copies of the listed relay swimmers to the Clerk of Course, Announcer and others.

**Any registered member of a team may participate in a relay of the appropriate gender and age group provided the relay(s) meets the above qualifications.**

### **Adaptive Swimming**

In accordance with USA Swimming rules; Articles 105.1 and 202.2.13, **the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities.** Qualifying times for 50-yard events will be waived for swimmers with a disability. Swimmers with a disability may enter events and they will be seeded into an age group with comparable times.

**Entries for swimmers with a disability will be deck seeded at the meet. The person in charge of team entries should notify the meet entry contact and state what the intended entries will be at the time entries are due.**

### **Meet Format:**

This meet will run as Prelims and Finals on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. **The Preliminary portion of this meet will be run with 10 lanes, and the Final session will be run with 8 lanes.** On each day there will be a Consolation and Championship heat in the Finals Session. The relays will be the first event of the Finals session each day. The relays will be swum as timed finals events. The 11-12 200 Backstroke, Butterfly, and Breaststroke and the 10 & Under 500 Freestyle will be swum as timed final events during morning preliminaries. The 11-12 400 IM will be swum as a timed final event on Wednesday night.

On Wednesday, the 1650 Freestyle will be seeded fastest to slowest and swum fastest to slowest alternating between girls and boys. The 1000 Freestyle on Saturday will be seeded fastest to slowest and swum fastest to slowest alternating between girls and boys. This event will be completed in its entirety during the preliminary session. Both the 1650 and 1000 yd. Freestyles are timed final events. **Swimmers competing in the 500, 1000, and 1650 Freestyles and the 11-12 200 Backstroke, 200 Breaststroke, 200 Butterfly, and 400 IM are responsible to provide their own timers and counters.**

### **Check-in Procedure:**

A "positive check-in" is required for the 1650 Freestyle and the 11-12 400 IM on Wednesday night by 5 PM. Check-in for the 1000 Freestyle on Saturday will close at 6 PM on Friday night. Swimmers that do not check in will not be allowed to swim in that event and will be automatically scratched from that event. All other events are a "negative check-in."

### **Scratch Procedure**

#### **UT2.3 UTAH SCRATCH PROCEDURE**

##### **.1 For Championship Meets (prelims and finals)**

The scratch box will be located at the Clerk of the Course. The scratch box shall close for the following day's events 30 minutes after the beginning of the final session each day. In a meet that begins with a timed final session on the first day, the scratch box for the next day's events will close 30 minutes after the start of that timed final session.

##### **.4 Penalties for Scored meets and Prelims events**

If a swimmer fails to scratch properly and doesn't report to the block to swim, that swimmer will be disqualified from that event and scratched from the next individual event for which he/she is entered. If a swimmer misses a second event, he/she will be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. In a championship meet with prelims and finals, upon request and approval of the Meet Referee, the barred swimmer can be re-entered into the meet and reseeded in the first heat of his/her remaining events to swim for time only but will neither be eligible to score points individually or for the club.

#### .5 Penalties for Final or Consolation Heats

A swimmer qualifying for either Consolation Finals or Championships Finals has 30 minutes after the time of the announcement of the qualifiers of each individual event to scratch. The Clerk of the Course will then seed the Consolation or the Championship heats by inserting alternates, thus filling all the lanes. Any swimmer qualifying for a Consolation or Championship final heat who fails to compete in that event shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. Declared false starts are not allowed for Consolation or Championship finals. Upon request and approval of the Meet Referee any barred swimmer can be re-entered into the meet and reseeded in the first heat of his/her remaining events and allowed to swim for time only, but will not be eligible to score points individually or for the club. After the final posting of the event, alternates are eligible to fill consolation heats.

#### .6 Results

Results from a preliminary competition are not the same as a final seeding posting. Any swimmer that may move into a finals seeding position as a result of scratches within the 30 minute time period is subject to all penalties outline in .5. Alternates as posted in the finals seeding are not subject to any penalty. It is the swimmers responsibility to know their final placement in their event before leaving the venue.

In addition, any swimmer missing a final or consolation heat on the final session of the meet will be subject to a \$50.00 fine that must be paid before said swimmer will be allowed to compete in any future Utah Swimming sanctioned events.

All swimmers, should they intend on not returning for finals for any reason, should properly scratch from all events with no regard for placement.

*Scratches for the Thursday morning Preliminary session must be turned into the Clerk of Course by 6 PM on Wednesday. Teams not participating Wednesday must contact Andy Sipple at [gasipple@gmail.com](mailto:gasipple@gmail.com) or (435) 901-0522.*

### **Qualifying Times:**

All entry times must be submitted in the course that they were swum in. There is no converting of times. All non-conforming times will be seeded after all the times swum in yards. Please see enclosed sheet for various courses' qualifying times. (Times will be verified off actual times swum)

### **Entries:**

Please submit all entries either on a disk or by e-mail ([asipp@att.net](mailto:asipp@att.net)) using Hy-tek software, or use the enclosed entry form. Teams entering on a disk must submit a signed hard copy with verification of times. Entries will not be accepted without time verification and one uniform entry sheet signed by the person responsible for entry submission. Said person will be responsible for all fines and penalties resulting from inaccurate times and unregistered swimmers. Teams using the official entry form must make sure that each form is signed and time verification is included on each entry. **NO TEAM'S ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE TEAM CONTACT INFORMATION SHEET AND VOLUNTEER SHEET FILLED OUT IN ITS ENTIRETY!**

**Warm-up:**

All warm-ups must be done under the supervision of a USA-S official. Coaches have the responsibility of insuring that all their swimmers are instructed in warm-up procedures and that the swimmers follow all Utah Swimming safety procedures. All swimmers will enter the pool from a 3 point sitting position. No pushing, splashing, running or any other general horseplay. Swimmers engaging in such activities will be asked to leave the pool. During the last 15 minutes of warm-up lanes 2, 4 and 7 will be opened for diving starts in the competition pool only and lanes 1 and 10 will be cleared for pace lanes under coach's supervision.

*In the Competition Pool, lanes 1- 5 will be for swimmers 11 & Under while lanes 6-10 will be for swimmers 12 & Over during prelims. The lap pool will also be available for warm up under a coach's supervision.*

**Unaccompanied Swimmers:**

As per USA Swimming rule 202.3.2, all USA Swimming athletes must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. If you do not have a coach with you, please check with the meet director or referee before entering the pool. A coach will be assigned.

## **VOLUNTEERS:**

It takes people filling over 250 volunteer slots to run a meet of this size. Teams have been assigned a pre-determined number of volunteer slots that they will need to fill. ***Volunteer sign-ups are due by 7 pm Tuesday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010.*** After the sign-up deadline unfilled volunteer slots will be assigned to teams that have not already filled their volunteer slot assessment. (See table below)

Teams are welcome to fill more than their assigned quota. (For example: A stroke and turn official on a small team is welcome, and encouraged, to work as many sessions as they can even if their team volunteer slot assessment is only 1 or 2)

Teams without an assigned volunteer slot assessment should provide at least 1 volunteer for 1 session. Volunteers from these teams may either sign-up in advance online or come to the Clerk of Course office 15 minutes prior to the meet start.

All teams will need to provide the name and contact information of a Team Volunteer Coordinator on the Team Information Sheet. ***Entries will not be accepted without this information.***

Volunteer sign-up guidelines:

- A number of slots may be filled by the same person. For example, the Meet Referee is present for all 7 sessions of the meet so 7 slots are filled.
- Either individuals or teams may sign-up.
  - If a team would like to claim a set of positions (For example: all the timers in lane 6) a team representative can go out and fill in all of those slots with the team name and the team representative's name, phone number & e-mail address. The team representative will then need to make the assignments and ensure that the positions are filled at the correct time during the meet.
  - If a family knows that they will only be attending certain sessions of the meet they may sign-up for the position of their choice for the session(s) that they will be attending and their team will still get credited for their help.
